Saint Agatha, a Sicilian woman who had consecrated herself to a life of virginity, was a third century martyr. Her beauty and virtue caught the attention of a Roman official, who desired her as his wife. When she refused his advances, declaring her commitment to God, she was subjected to horrific persecution. Agatha was imprisoned, tortured, and even had her breasts mutilated.

Despite her immense suffering, she remained steadfast in her faith, praying for the strength to endure. According to tradition, her faith sustained her until her death in 251 AD, which occurred amidst an earthquake believed to signal divine intervention. St. Agatha is celebrated as the patron saint of Sicily, breast cancer patients, nurses, and those seeking protection from fire and natural disasters.

- Finished baskets can be brought to the January or February CCW meeting.


We have a form that you will fill out to record the contents of the basket and approximate value.
