Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ's)

Q. Why do we need this campaign?

A. At the heart of this campaign is our commitment to serve others and respond to the continued growth of our parish. The new Our Mother's Attic Thrift Shop building will strengthen our outreach ministries and our ability to care for those in need. In addition, the campaign will support the expansion of our church, ensuring we have the space to welcome a growing parish family for worship, fellowship, and formation. Guided by the example of Saint Vincent de Paul, this campaign allows us to live our mission through both service and faith.

Q. What projects will this campaign support?

A. The campaign will support the construction of a new home for Our Mother's Attic Thrift Shop and the expansion of the church, including additional seating, improved worship technology, enhanced gathering space, and the conversion of the Family Life Center kitchen into a full-service kitchen to better support parish life and ministry.

Q. What is the goal of the campaign?

A. The goal of the campaign is to raise \$5.8 million, which will provide a significant portion of the funding needed to support these projects and advance the future of Saint Vincent de Paul Catholic Church.

Q. Who will be asked to participate in the campaign?

A. Every registered parish family will be invited to prayerfully consider participating in the campaign in a way that reflects their individual circumstances. Every gift makes a meaningful difference, no matter the amount.

Q. Will any portion be given to the Diocese?

A. No. All gifts made to the Saint Vincent de Paul Capital Campaign will be used exclusively to support the projects outlined for this parish.

Q. Why is my participation important?

A. When our parish family comes together in faith and generosity, we can accomplish far more than any one person alone. Each contribution helps strengthen our mission and supports the future of Saint Vincent de Paul Catholic Church.

Q. How long is the pledge period?

A. Pledges may be fulfilled over a three-year period. The Discipleship and Stewardship Office within the Diocese of Orlando will manage the pledges, and donors may choose both the payment frequency and method of payment on their pledge card.

Q. Are my payments to the campaign tax-deductible?

A. Yes. Saint Vincent de Paul Catholic Church is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization, and gifts are tax-deductible to the extent allowed by law. A receipt for total contributions of \$250 or more within one calendar year (as required by the IRS) will be provided each January for income tax purposes. Parishioners with specific questions are encouraged to consult their attorney, accountant, or tax preparer.
